New Frontiers in the ICU

[Hot off the press](#) is a first observational study exploring the utilization of NOL monitoring for mechanically ventilated patients in the ICU. [The study](#) (published in Pain Management Nursing) has found that NOL can distinguish between painful vs. nonpainful procedures in ICU ventilated patients. This study, in combination with the [SCCM guidelines from 2018](#), reveals the great potential of NOL monitoring to guide clinicians in optimizing pain control in the intensive care unit.


